Each year the Wichita Diocese recognizes adults in Girl Scout or Camp Fire units who serve Catholic Youth by awarding them either the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton OR St. Anne Medal. It affirms the work of those who help youth develop their **spiritual** lives within these organizations.

If you know of an adult who is deserving of recognition, please take a look at the following information on how to process a nomination. We need to be sure to recognize those who have been integral in the **spiritual formation** of Catholic youth.

Suggested candidate qualifications:

- The kind of person sought as a recipient of an adult recognition should be one of excellent character.
- Recipients should be adults currently active within these organizations.
- Awards may be given to clergy, religious, non-Catholics, laymen or women.
- Catholic recipients should have the support of their respective pastors.
- The nominated person should have several years active service to youth as an adult member for the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton award and at least 5 years for the St. Anne award.

If you know a worthy candidate for this award, please take the time to nominate him/her for recognition. The deadline for submitting nominations is March 1.

At least one other letter of recommendation written by someone other than the person filling out this form, or the pastor, must accompany this nomination.
